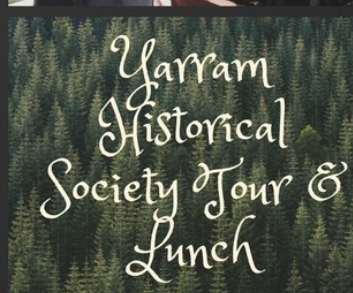
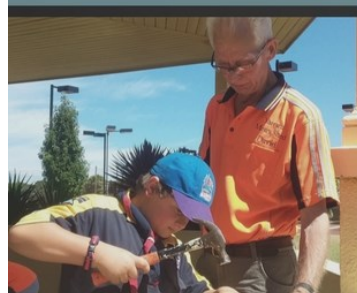

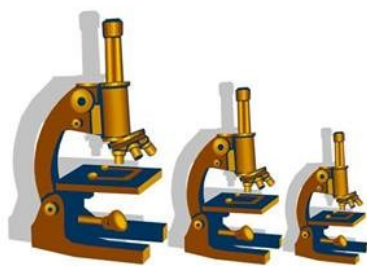

YDHS is currently recruiting to a variety of volunteer roles within the health service.

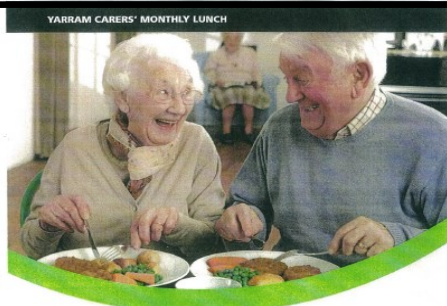
We are currently seeking:
